Grantham Structure Plan

It has been more than 13 years since the original Grantham Reconstruction Area Plan came into effect. The community played an important role in forming the plan and deciding what the future of Grantham could look like, ensuring it remained a place for vibrant rural living.

Thanks to the Australian Government's Housing Support Program, a unique opportunity has arisen to create a Grantham Structure Plan. This project will allow us to plan for the future land use of Grantham including the homes and businesses that enable the community to grow and prosper.

While many of the aspirations of the original plan have been realised, the Grantham Structure Plan project provides the opportunity for the community to build on the changes that have occurred and share their vision for the future of Grantham.

The Grantham Structure Plan project will focus on and plan for the critical matters that support a community – roads, infrastructure, parks, services, housing, businesses, community facilities and liveability – and inform a future planning scheme amendment.

To lead this project, Council has engaged Brisbane-based firm PSA Consulting to work with the community, Council and other stakeholders to create a contemporary vision for Grantham.

You are invited to join Council and PSA for an initial workshop and follow-up briefings over the coming months to help create the Grantham Structure Plan.
